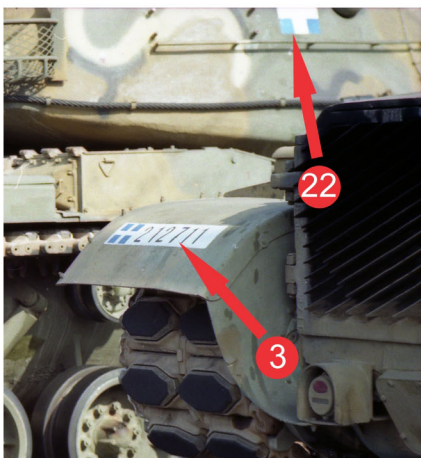


# Hellenic Army M60A1 & M60A3 tanks

The first M60A1 and A3 tanks to enter service with the Hellenic Army came from US Army stocks. They were delivered in their American four colour MERDC camouflage which consisted of FS37038 (black), FS34079 (forest green), FS 30118 (field drab) and FS30277 (sand). The American shades of the camouflage colours were slightly different to the shades usually used by the Hellenic Army and also the finish was on most tanks faded and worn. All US markings were painted over in Greek colours, which generally looked darker, leaving a patchy finish. Hellenic Army number plates and national insignia on both sides of the turret were added. Gradually all tanks were repainted in Greek colours as they were overhauled.

**NOTE:** The position of all the markings was identical on all tanks.





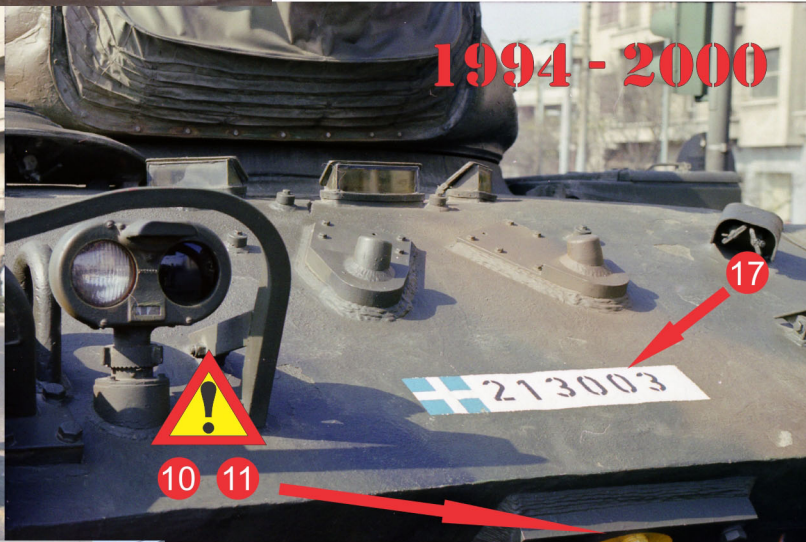


This M60A3 tank had attachment points for Tank Mounted Mine Clearing Rollers (TMMCR). The styles of its number plate and bridge class marking changed over the years when it was repainted. The modeler is provided with a choice of markings for the bridge class marking depending on if one wants to paint the yellow disc or use the decal.

Over the years M60A1/A3 tanks started to display a mix of wheel types. Both M60 type aluminium wheels with strengthening gussets and steel M48 type wheels were used. The latter type gradually dominated the scene.

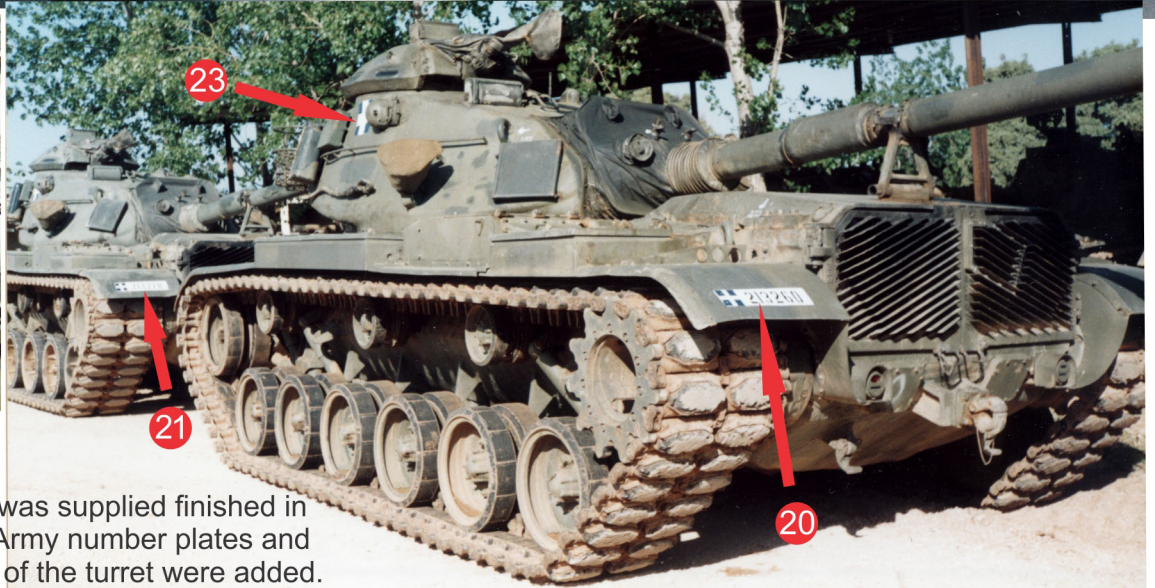
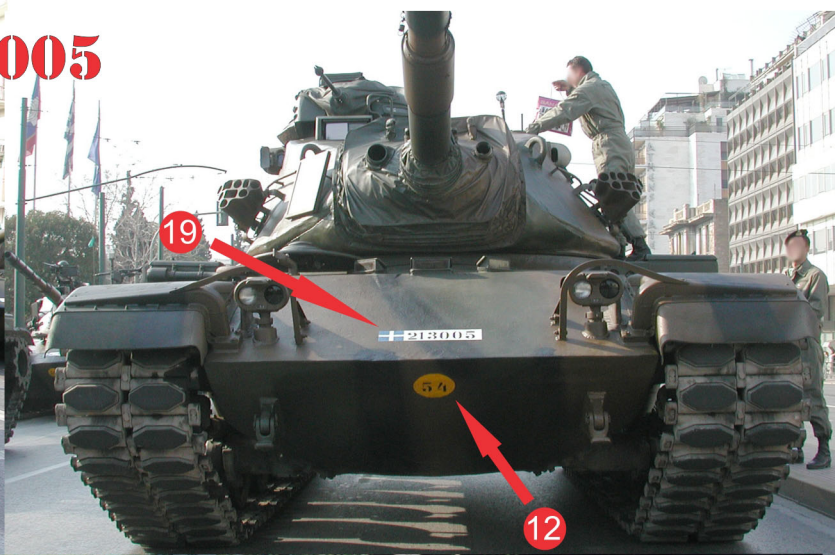
