

PzH2000GR self propelled howitzer



The Hellenic Army employs 24 PzH2000GR self propelled howitzers which entered service in 2004. The Greek vehicles are finished in the unique four colour camouflage scheme seen in the photos. The camouflage pattern is fairly consistent on all vehicles.

All Greek artillery pieces, both towed and self propelled carry a unique marking in the form of a brass icon of St. Barbara who is the artillery's patron saint. This decal must be applied on a piece of plasticard approx. 0.5 - 0.6 mm (20 thou) thick. Two alternative positions are possible as seen in the two photos above.





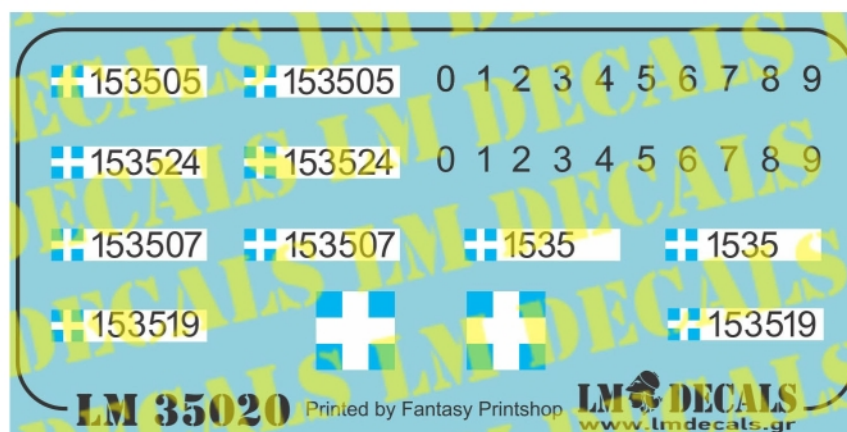
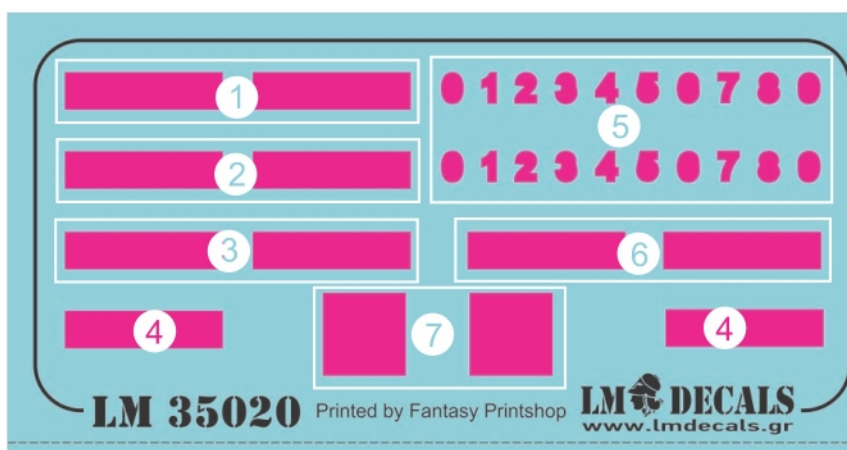
There is a choice of 4 different number plates or by combining markings **6** and **5** the modeller may portray any PzH2000GR self propelled howitzer in Hellenic Army service. Any markings not included in this set are provided in the kit's markings.
